**No.SUP.24/2021/1248** – In continuation of this Department's Advertisement No.SUP.24/2021/1247 dated 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2024 for filling up of the posts of Members of the Meghalaya State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission (State Commission), Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs Department hereby extends the last date of applying for the posts of Members in the State Commission by another 2(two) weeks of issuance of this advertisement i.e. upto **13<sup>th</sup> September, 2024.**

Eligibility criteria is as follows:-

1. The applicant should not be less than forty years of age;
2. The applicant should possess an experience of at least ten years as presiding officer of a district court or of any tribunal at equivalent level or combined service as such in the district court and tribunal; OR
3. The candidate should possess a bachelor's degree from a recognised University and is a person of ability, integrity and standing, and has special knowledge and **professional experience of not less than ten years** in Consumer Affairs, Law, Public Affairs, Administration, Economics, Commerce, Industry, Finance, Management, Engineering, Technology, Public Health or Medicine.
4. The Selection shall be on the basis of performance in a written test consisting of two papers as specified in the table below and viva voce of 50 marks.
